ORDINANCE NO. 1427

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MARION, KANSAS EXEMPTING CERTAIN PROPERTY FROM RESTRICTIONS RELATED TO THE TEMPORARY SALE OR CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOL AND CEREAL MALT BEVERAGES AT DESIGNATED LOCATIONS WITHIN THE CITY.

WHEREAS, The Elected Governing Body of the City of Marion, Kansas have determined that the temporary sale or consumption of alcohol and cereal malt beverages at the property commonly known as the Historic Elgin Hotel based upon the finding of the Governing Body that the proximity of the property is not adverse to the public welfare or safety of the citizens and guests of our city..

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF MARION, KANSAS:

SECTION 1: The property commonly known as the Historic Elgin Hotel, locates at 115 N Third Street, Marion, Kansas shall be exempt from the application of Section 3-102 (c) of the City Code of Marion Kansas, and Section 4 of Ordinance 1248, and K.S.A. 41-710; based upon a finding by the Governing Body that the proximity of the subject property is not adverse to the public welfare or safety.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its adoption by the governing body of the City, approval by the Mayor and publication of a summary hereof certified as legally accurate and sufficient by the City Attorney in the Official Newspaper of the City on time.
